Instructions for registering

Registering for the Research Methods in Legal Communication reading group is a two-step process: You must first register as a user on the LegalCommunication.org website. You must then enroll in the RMLC ‘course.’¹

Registering on the site

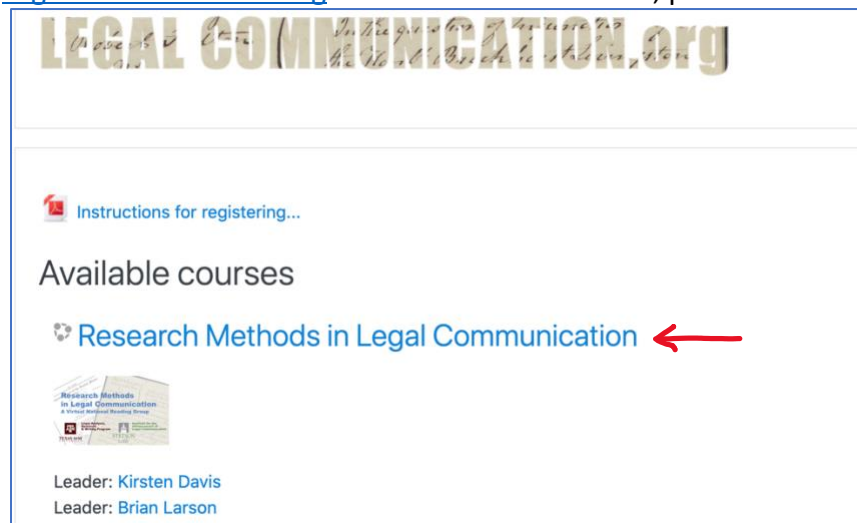


Figure 1 Legal Communication home page

1. First go to LegalCommunication.org. You should see a screen, part of which looks like Figure 1:

2. Click on “Research Methods in Legal Communication” (red arrow in Figure 1). You should see a screen, part of which looks like Figure 2.

¹ Because we are hosting the reading group on an instantiation of the Moodle learning management system, it looks at participation as enrollment (or ‘enrolment’—as Moodle is an Aussie product) in a ‘course.’

3. Click on “Create new account” (red arrow in figure 2). You should see a screen, part of which looks like Figure 3. Fill out all the required boxes (red circles next to them). The *Username* field should have only lowercase letters and numerals in it.

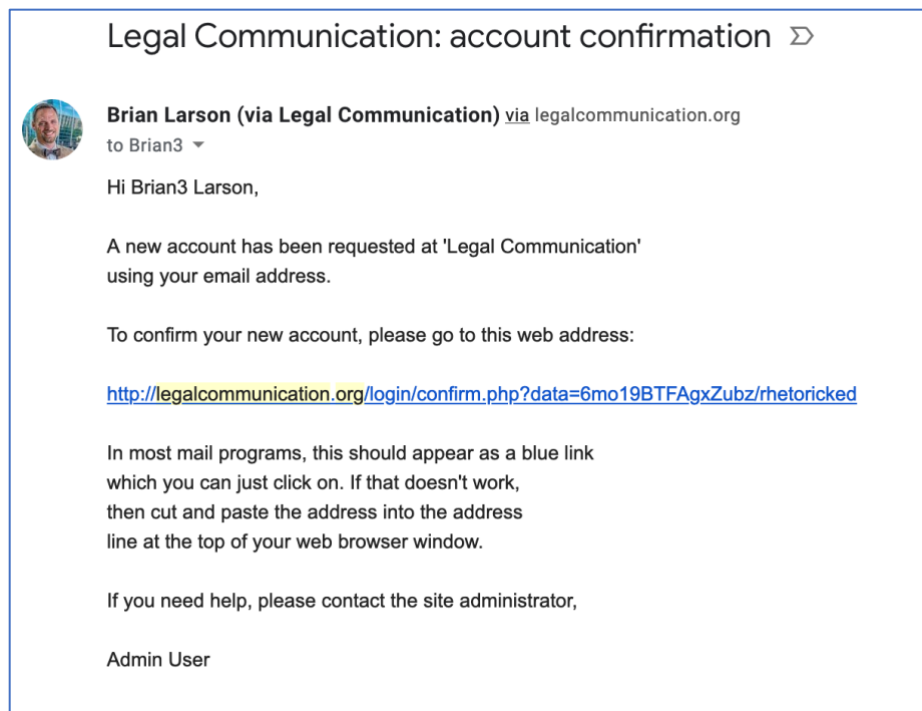


Figure 4 Registration confirmation email

4. You should receive an email that looks something like Figure 4. Click on the link in it (or copy and paste it into your browser) to confirm your registration on the site.

Enrolling in the reading group ('course')

1. Return to LegalCommunication.org. Log in, if you have not already. If you are logged in, you may see a dashboard screen, which will look confusingly empty. If so, just click the "Site Home" button in the menu on the left, and you should see a screen, part of which looks like Figure 1 above.

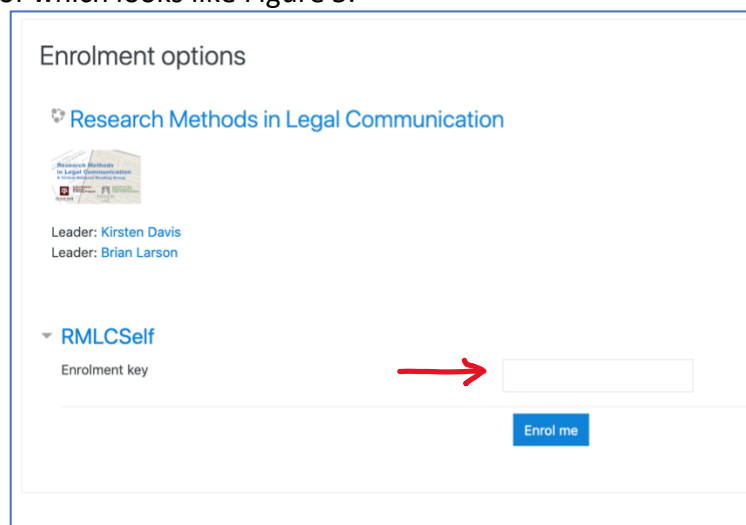


Figure 5 Course enrollment

2. Click on "Research Methods in Legal Communication" (red arrow in Figure 1). You should now see a screen, part of which looks like Figure 5.

3. Enter the enrollment key you received in the "Enrolment key" box (red arrow on Figure 5) and click the "Enrol me" button.
4. You are in the RMLC reading group ('course')!
